Some places will be new to you.




When you arrive at school in the morning, you will line-up on the playground here. Remember to bring your book bag, water bottle and raincoat.

We would like to make a display with your hot air balloons, ready for your classroom in September, so please email them to us before the end of term or drop them in to your current class teacher for our attention.


